

Piedmont Airlines' new Boeing 737 jetliner sits on a ramp at Smith Reynolds Airport after its arrival Thursday from Wilmington. The plane was picked up in Seattle, Wash., by Piedmont officials and was flown non-stop to Wilmington in 4 hours, 46 minutes and 15 seconds. The \$3.3-million liner will go into service on Piedmont's New York-Atlanta-Winston-Salem run on July 1. The airline is scheduled to buy six of the planes.
